The St. Johns Cultural Council Directory of the Arts (“Directory”) Privacy Policy

The St. Johns Cultural Council (“Cultural Council”) is committed to protecting the privacy of our users. We want to provide a safe, secure user experience. We will use our best efforts to ensure that the information you submit to us remains private, and it is used only for the purposes described below.

Information About All Visitors to the Cultural Council Directory

In general, we gather information about all of our users collectively, such as what areas users visit most frequently and what services users access the most. This information helps us determine what is most beneficial for our users, and how we can continually create a better overall experience for you. We may share this information with our partners, but only in the aggregate, so that they, too, may understand how visitors use our site for the purpose of creating a better overall experience for directory users.

Information About Artists
